Grasslands: Chain-link Snake Craft

Materials:

- 2-3 sheets of blank paper
- Scissors – please have an adult help you with any cutting
- Markers/crayons/colored pencils
- Tape

Steps:

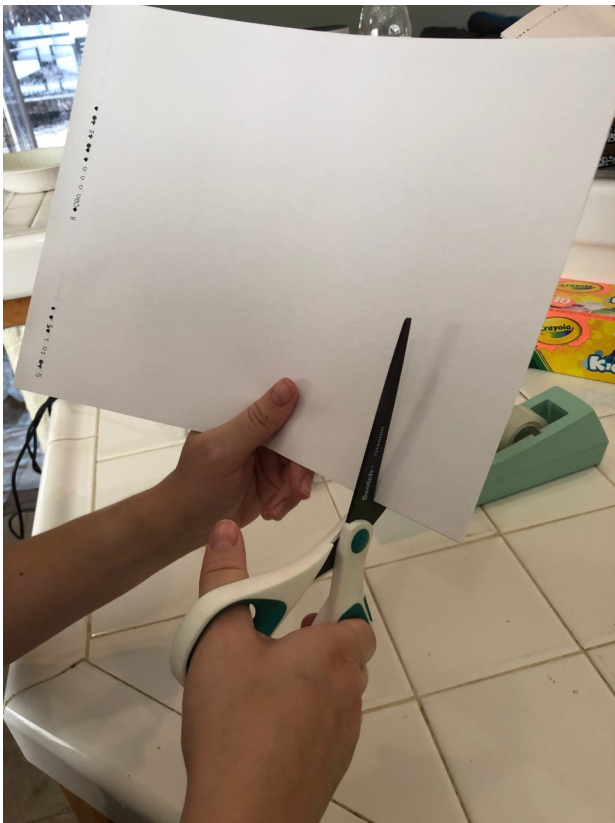
1. Gather your materials!

Steps:

2. Stack your 2-3 sheets of paper.
3. Cut the stack into ~2 inch wide strips – short ways. You should have at least 8 strips but you can add more to make your snake longer!



Grasslands: Chain-link Snake Craft

Steps:

4. Now give your snake a pattern! Decorate the strips however you'd like, get creative! Don't forget to add eyes, nostrils, and even a tongue to one of the strips. This will be the snake's face! You can make a tongue out of excess paper or just draw it on.



Grasslands: Chain-link Snake Craft

Steps:

5. Grab one decorated strip and tape the ends together, making a circle.



6. Grab another strip and place it through the first one. Tape the ends together.



Grasslands: Chain-link Snake Craft

Steps:

7. Continue linking the strips of paper together and make sure you link the snake's head on the front of the chain.



Your chain-link snake is ready to be placed in its grassland habitat!
