

# Ocean Habitat

SHARK FORTUNE TELLER CRAFT



#### **Materials:**


- A blank sheet of white paper
- A ruler
- Glue or tape
- Pen or pencil
- Scissors (please ask an adult to help you with any cutting)
- Markers, colored pencils, crayons, etc.






#### **Instructions:**

1. Use a ruler to measure a 7 inch by 7 inch square on the blank sheet of paper. Cut out the square and save the extra strip of paper that you cut off.






2. On the square piece of paper, find the middle point on each side of the square and use the ruler to trace a diamond shape. On the extra strip of paper, draw out two shark pectoral fins (the ones on the sides), and two dorsal fins (the pointier ones on top). Cut out the fins and save them for later.





3. On the square piece of paper, draw the pattern below and color it accordingly.









#### Now it's time to fold!


4. Flip the square piece of paper over so you are looking at the blank side. Start by folding the paper in half, so that the side with the eyes on it is facing up. Open the paper back up.








5. Turn the paper and fold it in half again, so that you see only one eye facing up. When you open the paper up, you should have two folds that make a cross.










6. Next, fold each corner in to the middle of the cross. You will end up with a diamond shape.






7. Flip the diamond shape over, so you are looking at the blank side. Fold each corner in towards the middle. You will end up with a square shape once again.










8. Fold the square in half. To make your shark 3-Dimensional, gently open each pocket that you just created in the paper.










9. Glue or tape on the pectoral fins on the bottom left and right sides. Glue the dorsal fin onto the fold between the shark's eyes!







Your shark is complete! To make your shark move, slip your fingers into each pocket in the paper and you can open and close the shark's mouth.

For more fun, open the interior panels and write your favorite shark facts inside. Number the outside panels. Play the fortune teller game to quiz your friends and family!
